

## Presbyterian Women (PW) Outreach Opportunities

**Are you a collector of “stuff”?** You will find PW Outreach boxes just below the officers’ mailboxes, located in the office hallway. Involve your children in collecting for these service projects!

1. **Thornwell Home for Children:** Lists of qualified products can be found with the drop-off box:
  - **Tyson Project A+ Labels**
  - **General Mills Box Tops for Education**
2. **Area Churches Together Serving (ACTS)**
  - **BI-LO Bonuscards** can be registered with the BI-LO Boosterplus program to have 1% of your purchases donated to ACTS. An ACTS enrollment scan card is needed to register your BI-LO Bonuscard; these are available on the shelf just below the officers’ mailboxes in the office hallway. Scan card enrollment must be renewed annually after May 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - **Kroger Rewards** Cards earn extra funds for ACTS. To register, visit [krogercommunityrewards.com](http://krogercommunityrewards.com) and click the link “Enroll now for the Kroger Community Rewards Program”. Designate ACTS as your recipient by entering nonprofit number 89876. Kroger Rewards cards will need to be registered online once each year to earn extra funds for ACTS.
3. **Cumbee Center**
  - **Hotel size bath products (soap, shampoo, conditioner, and moisturizer)** are collected and donated to the Cumbee Center.
4. **St. Jude’s Ranch for Children**
  - **Recycled Greeting Cards:** All types of cards, excluding Hallmark, Disney, and American Greeting cards, are acceptable. Only the card front can be used and the backside should be clear of any writing.
