Serve the Church Facility

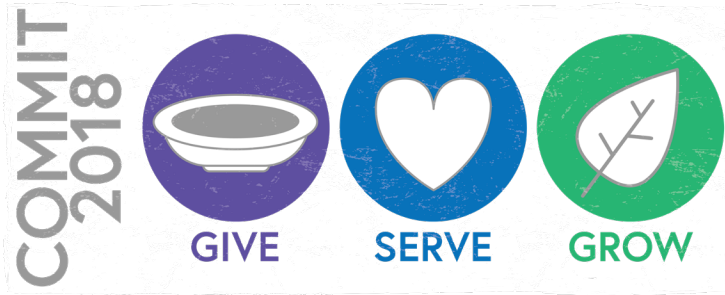
Serve the church facility by making minor repairs and providing needed maintenance to the building.
