Kathy Clark, pianist

Kathy Clark earned both bachelor and masters degrees in music education from the University of Arkansas. She has taught kindergarten through 5th grade music in both public and private schools in Arkansas, Texas, Alabama, and Georgia. While teaching in Arkansas, Mrs. Clark served as the state president of the general music division of the Arkansas Music Teachers Association. At River Eves Elementary School in Roswell, GA, she was 2009 Teacher of the Year.

In all locations, the chorus Kathy conducted performed musicals each year, complete with choreography, costumes, and staging. The River Eves Chorus sang yearly at an Atlanta Braves game, the Roswell Tree Lighting, and at a Gladiator hockey game to raise money for the school. In 2010, the chorus sang at the Governor's Christmas Open House, and in 2014 at the dedication of the new Roswell City Library.

Church service includes time as Music Director for the Lutheran Church of Vestavia Hills in Birmingham, AL, and at Covenant Presbyterian Church in Marietta, Georgia. While in Atlanta, Mrs. Clark served as music associate for 13 years at Mount Vernon Presbyterian Church where she directed the handbell choir and children's choirs. In addition she has been guest organist for many churches in the cities where she's lived.

Kathy feels privileged to serve as organist/pianist at First Presbyterian Church and is excited to share some of her favorite piano music in honor of musicians who have influenced her. Kathy lives in Evans, GA where her husband, Harvey, is employed at the Augusta Veterans Affairs Medical Center. Community service includes assisted animal therapy visits with her dog, Butler, volunteering in various capacities at Sacred Heart Cultural Center where currently she is co-chair for the annual Nine Lessons and Carols event, and participating in the Holy Comforter Prayer Shawl Ministry.
