Education- BFA Michigan State University, Ceramics & Printmaking Other skills – card making, hand-dying fabrics, wool applique', and knitting

Quilting- I started quilting about 40 years ago. Coming from a clothing background, I had to learn different skills to cut and sew flat square, precise quilt blocks to fit together accurately. Long ago I learned that; "COLOR gets all the credit, VALUE does all the work". That is a good reminder for all types of artistic pursuits.

À quilt is two layers of fabric with batting in between, held together by machine or hand stitching.

Painters can mix colors. Fabrics need to be collected over time to have a large palette to choose from.

I like the challenge of working with a prompt or theme, and learning different techniques. I usually make smaller pieces rather than full size quilts, as they are easier to design and finish. Quilts, like other physical items, are made by drawing, drafting, engineering, designing, measuring, collecting fabrics, cutting and sewing. Sometimes a quilter will use a purchased pattern by a quilt designer. Quilt patterns are like a good recipe with suggestions of elements that work well together. Most of my quilts are original designs. I like to machine piece, and applique'. All these parts together become an expression of the reaction to an idea or prompt, and executed in fabric. Many of my quilts have won awards in our local guild annual quilt show. Each quilt is an individual piece.






